#### DIGITAL FLUENCY ACCELERATOR MICRO-CREDENTIAL

The Digital Fluency Accelerator Micro-credential is a bilingual, asynchronous designed micro-credential for postsecondary online and hybrid learners at Ontario's publicly-assisted Indigenous institutes, colleges and universities. The purpose of this micro-credential is to facilitate the acquisition of digital fluency skills required to foster learner success in online and hybrid learning environments. Learners will explore digital tools and technologies and employ the necessary sustainable and transferable skills required for effective online learning, such as, managing digital files, digital design creation, safe digital communication, and digital navigation. By the end of this micro-credential, learners will have the capacity to adopt and implement the digital fluency competencies essential for effective engagement in online and hybrid learning environments.

#### **OPPORTUNITY**

Could the adoption of a Digital Fluency Accelerator Micro-credential program help mitigate online and hybrid learning challenges experienced by your learners? Do your learners struggle with the necessary digital fluency skills for effective online engagement? Is your institution looking for self-directed options to prepare learners for online and hybrid learning?

The eCampusOntario is accepting expressions of interest (EOI) for Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassadors from Ontario's publicly-assisted Indigenous institutions, colleges and universities. These Ambassadors will hold positions within educational departments as faculty or academic student support staff. Indigenous and Francophone faculty and academic student support staff are strongly encouraged to participate in assisting to shape the future of digital fluency skills for all learners. This micro-credential pilot project will launch September 2023. eCampusOntario recognizes and acknowledges participation arrangements which are flexible and encourages Ambassadors who are interested in enhancing the digital fluency skills of their learners to participate.

#### **APPLICANT RESPONSIBILITIES**

Successful Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassador applicants will be responsible for:

- > Promoting the Digital Fluency Accelerator Micro-credential within their institution
- > Recruiting 10 faculty who can facilitate the micro-credential with their learners
- > Informing eCampusOntario on the number of learners participating in the pilot
- > Encouraging program participants to collect their digital credentials upon program completion
- Providing learner support during micro-credential program facilitation
- Circulating and completing the program assessment survey; and,
- > Providing eCampusOntario with a required final report on the micro-credential's effectiveness at their institution and the number of credentialed participants

This EOI is incentivized and will be awarded as per the specified application guidelines. Up to 10 Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassadors will be selected. No more than one ambassador will be appointed within each institution.

#### **FINANCIAL SUPPORT**

Financial support for this program will be provided directly to the educational department to support promotion of this program, and their own digital transformation activities. Each Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassador will receive an honorarium of \$2,000 and an allowance of \$10,000 for their educational department to support the program. Ambassador applicants are required to have the ability to enter into an MOU between eCampusOntario and their Institution, or the approval of the appropriate department head.

- a. Name
- b. Program
- c. Number of learner participants

#### 4. Ambassador Engagement

- a. Explain how the Digital Fluency Accelerator Micro-credential will be promoted within the institution
- Explain how learner support will be provided to the participants
   (Example biweekly virtual question and answer support sessions or office hours)
- c. Explain how the stipend funds will benefit the educational department

## **Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassador Eligibility**

- Employed within an educational department as faculty (including contract faculty) or academic student support staff at an Ontario publicly-assisted Indigenous institution, college or university
- Approval of the appropriate department head
- EOI application meets requirements
  - No late applications will be accepted
  - EOI application must be submitted online only
  - EOI application must be submitted fully complete
- Commitment to complete the required final report

## **Technical Requirements**

As a Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassador, you must ensure that all participating parties have reliable access to:

- A stable internet connection
- Email
- The institution's learning management system (LMS)
  - Alternatively, Contact North may grant learner enrollment within their LMS (Moodle)

## **Participation**

As a Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassador, you will:

- Agree to the applicants responsibilities
- Follow the application guidelines and submit a complete EOI application
- Agree to the required final report
- Agree to the expectations set forth in the timeline
- Meet the eligibility criteria
- Meet the technical requirements for participation
- Provide consent through an eCampusOntario provided media release to be profiled as a Digital Fluency Accelerator Ambassador on the eCampusOntario website/social media channels
