About eCampusOntario

eCampusOntario is a not-for-profit organization that accelerates the transformation of postsecondary digital learning in Ontario to increase participation in higher education. The organization leads a consortium of the province's publicly-assisted colleges, universities and Indigenous institutes to advance the development and adoption of online and digital learning technologies, programs and environments.

The Opportunity

eCampusOntario is establishing a community of practice (CoP) around experiential learning in Franco-Ontarian settings to guide the expansion of materials and programming available in French in the province. This CoP would serve as an advisory group to the Consortium d'apprentissage expérientiel francophone de l'Ontario (CAPFO). CAPFO is a program established by eCampusOntario to help bridge the gap between available francophone industry projects and the francophone postsecondary education sector in Ontario looking to partner for experiential learning opportunities.

We are seeking six (6) volunteer committee members with the expertise to provide insights in experiential education and work-integrated learning. The committee members will help advance experiential education skills of educators to enable enhanced learning opportunities for learners.



The experiential learning CoP will be a framework for cohesion, consultation, resource pooling, sharing and development between French, bilingual and English language institutions engaged in work to advance francophone experiential learning activities and interests. The committee will focus on enhancing digital solutions to help educators prepare learners with the important skills that prepare them for a meaningful future.

The CoP will support and advise eCampusOntario on:

- The professional development (PD) of postsecondary francophone educators in experiential learning (EL) and digital work-integrated learning (WIL) teaching practice;
- The curation and uptake of EL and WIL education resources and solutions available in the eCampusOntario Open Library and across institutions;
- The insights and recommendations about the future of EL and WIL, and challenges associated to EL-based and WIL-based learning.

Meetings will be conducted in French and take place virtually.

Approximately four meetings are anticipated per annum. The inaugural meeting will be scheduled for mid-February 2024.

- Firsthand user experience with experiential education in-person, hybrid and/or online
